



Coronavirus update

The World Health Organisation (WHO) has declared the status of COVID-19 to be of pandemic level, but stresses that the risk to individuals remains moderate as long as they are taking appropriate caution and following the advice of their regional health bodies and local governments. We advise that individuals remain vigilant and take caution where possible to prevent the further spread of the disease.

The health and safety of our guests, speakers, colleagues, sponsors and local partners are of utmost importance. We are continuing to monitor the spread of the Novel Coronavirus and are following the advice of local government and public health officials including the ECDC, CDC and WHO.

If you are travelling for an event, we ask all attendees who have travelled to China in the last month to ensure that at least 24 days have passed from the time they arrived from China to the event and that they have shown no flu-like symptoms during the time. If you have, we ask that, for your own safety and the safety of other attendees, you please send another attendee in your stead and refrain from attending the event.

Please note if you have returned from the following areas since February 19 you should get in contact with your health practitioner, stay indoors and avoid contact with people even if you don't have symptoms.

- · China Hubei Province
- · Iran
- · Italy
- · Spain
- · South Korea
- Vietnam
- · Cambodia
- Laos
- Myanmar

If you have not travelled to these areas but are unwell or feeling flu-like symptoms, even if these are mild, we recommend you stay at home and send someone on your behalf to attend the event.

Please check government and WHO or regional health administration guidelines for the latest guidance and recommendations for any country to which you will travel.





Refund policy

In the event of not being able to travel to an event due to company travel restrictions or government recommendations, a full refund of your ticket will be issued upon request up to 5 working days prior to the event.

If an event is cancelled or postponed by EuroFinance/CPI, you may transfer the credit to a different event or request a full refund of your tickets.
